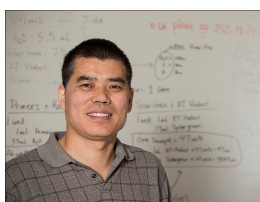
## 2020 JZUS-B Special Issue on **non-coding RNA**
